Hodge* dec^d hath been required upon the motion of the *Shrop* sh^r to give Counter Security, and said *Perry* refusing to give Counter Security and *Nancy Hodge* and *John Perry* the above bond be *John Perry* as Counter Security is received as

or into the hands or possession of any

other person or persons, for *her*

and the same so made, do exhibit

into the county Court of Livingston, at such time as *she* shall be thereun-

to required by the said court, and such goods, chattles and credits, do well and

truly administer. according to law, and further do make a just and true account of

all *her* actings and doings therein, when thereunto required by the said

court; and all the rest of the said goods, chattles and credits, which shall be found

remaining upon the account of the said administrator, the same being first examined

and allowed by the Justices of the said court for the time being, shall deliver and

pay unto such persons respectively, as are entitled to the same by law; and if it

shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament was made by the deceased,

and the same be proved in court, and the executors obtain a certificate of the pro-

bate thereof, and the said *Nancy Hodge*

do in such case being required, render and deliver up *her*

letters of administration, then this obligation to be void, else remain in full force and

virtue.
